

NZOIA Membership Fee Increase 2022/23

In accordance with section 7.17 in the Constitution, the subscription fees for the next financial year will be set at the AGM.

Due to inflation, NZOIA's fixed operating costs continue to increase annually. However, grant funding which amounts to 24% of our income does not increase accordingly and has become harder to access because of reduced funding pools and changing criteria. To meet the shortfall, we need to consider an increase to membership fees. The consumer price index was 2.5% on 30 June 2020 and a further 3.3% on 30 June 2021. Membership fees have not increased for the last 3 years. Every effort is made to keep Membership fees as low as possible to stay viable and support our members.

Motion: The Board proposes a \$5.00 increase to Full Membership Fees for the 2022/23 financial year (2.3% increase). Associate and Affiliated Membership to stay the same.
