Chair Report and Management Report	<p>Gill tabled the Management Report and Chair Report.</p> <p>Key Points: Another busy year:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 5% membership growth. 1137 members. - Close to 400 qualifications awarded - Sport NZ funding - \$100k pa secured for the next 3 years - Strategic direction discussions have begun on how we position ourselves for the next three years. Discussion Paper has been put to membership for feedback. - New qualifications have been developed for Mountain Bike and Artificial White Water. - Affiliated membership - new membership model introduced aimed at organisations with Leader level staffing. - Continue to grow and offer support to the tourism industry - Budgeted loss for 2016/17 and again in 2017/18 to enable project work using some of our cash reserves - Acknowledgement and thank you to the NZOIA Office staff – Penny Holland, Sonya Sutherland, Pip Russell, Steff Willmore for the work they do. <p>4. Financial Report</p>	<p>Financial Report for 2016/17 tabled.</p> <p>The Board budgeted for a deficit in 2016/17 so work could continue on projects. The deficit came in at less than budget: Budgeted: -\$61k, Actual: -\$46k, Reserves \$330k. We have budgeted for a deficit again in 2017/18 to continue projects. It is not planned to continue budgeting to a deficit beyond 2017/18. <p>5. Review of code of ethical practice</p>	<p>At the AGM last year it was agreed the Code of Ethical Practice (CoEP) would be reviewed annually. Changes to the wording as per the 2016 AGM has been made. Jo Thompson received no feedback in the lead up to the 2017 AGM. If you want to see changes or have feedback please contact NZOIA board member Jo Thompson.</p> <p>There was discussion on operating within the scope of NZOIA qualifications and the process if a member is observed to be carrying out unsafe process/not following the CoEP. It was noted that for the Board to take action, members need to be proactive in putting their concerns in writing to the board as per the CoEP and process for Professional Misconduct - so the board can action and follow due process. It was noted that the CoEP is not the law. It is a guide on how things should run. A reminder will be put in the 4YA on the CoEP, scope and the process for members to raise misconduct concerns.</p>
